House-Banked Card Room (HBCR) submission for rule change: WAC 230-15-040

CONSOLIDATED (TOTAL) BETTING ON A RESERVED/PRIVATE BACCARAT TABLE

- HBCR may offer a private table for a Player (or Players) that:
 - Is separated from the other tables in a manner such as stanchions or signage so that it is obvious to any other players that the table is a private table; or
 - The table may be segregated by situating it in a dedicated private room.
- HBCR may, at their discretion, allow a player, when playing an entire designated private Baccarat table, to place the total bet for all player betting positions in one betting spot, subject to the following conditions;
 - The bet, win, commission are clearly fanned;
 - The other betting spots will be blocked with a marker (see diagram);
 - No back betting will be permitted at the table;
 - Appropriate signage to inform players is posted at tables
