Dear Ms. Kimball,

We have reviewed the changes made to 2 Card Poker. Based on our review of the documentation we received from AGS, LLC, the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

- The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the "2 Card Poker Rules of Play" you provided on January 20, 2016 and are enclosed.

Commercial Card Rooms

- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

Tribal Casinos

- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.
- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.

- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

RULES OF PLAY

2 Card Poker is an exciting game where players are dealt four cards and play their best two card poker hand. 2 Card Poker is dealt from a 52 card deck with conventional values.

1. To begin play, all players must make an Ante wager.
2. Players may also make an optional 2 Card Bonus wager and/or 4 Card Bonus wager.
3. Each player and the dealer will be dealt four cards (face down) to make the best two card poker hand. Hand rankings are as follows:
 - a. Pairs (A's - 2's); then
 - b. Straight Flushes (A/K suited is high and A/2 suited is low); then
 - c. Flushes (A/Q suited is high and 2/4 suited is low); then
 - d. High card if no flush (straights have no value)
4. The player may inspect their hand and then choose from the following options:
 - a. Fold the hand:
 - i. A player that folds will forfeit the Ante and throw in all four cards.
 - ii. If the player made the 2 Card Bonus wager and qualifies with a pair of 7's or better but chooses to fold the hand and not match the Ante, then the player will tuck the winning two cards under the 2 Card Bonus wager or else fold and throw in all four cards.
 - iii. If the player made the 4 Card Bonus wager, the player will tuck the two cards of their choice under the 4 Card Bonus wager and is still eligible for payouts even if they fold the Ante wager.
 - b. Make a Call Bet (Bet or Fold) equal to the Ante wager: If a Call Bet is made, then the player will discard the two cards not used for their two card poker hand. The two cards the player will play go in the box that says "cards" next to the betting circles.

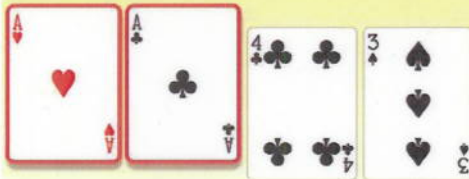
5. After all players act on their hand, the dealer will then turn over the dealer's cards and determine which two cards to play and which two cards will be moved to the discard rack.
6. The dealer must qualify to play with a minimum Jack high flush. In the event the dealer does not hold a qualifying hand, the Call Bets will receive no action (push) and the Ante will be paid even money.
7. The dealer will pay the Ante and Call Bet even money if the player's hand outranks the dealer's qualifying hand.
8. The Ante and Call Bet will push when the player's hand ties the dealer's hand.
9. The 2 Card Bonus is paid odds when players receive a pair of 7's or higher and is based off the player's two card poker hand only.
10. The 4 Card Bonus is paid odds when players have two pair or better and is based off the player and dealer's combined two card poker hands only. Straights do not apply.
11. A payable listing all payouts for both Bonus bets will be posted at the table along with the minimum and maximum betting limits.

Operators cannot allow wagering limits to exceed the authorized limits set out in WAC 230-15-040 and WAC 230-15-140.

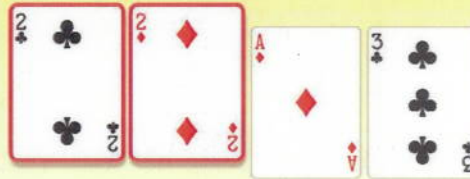
The player's pair of Aces beats the dealer's pair of Kings.

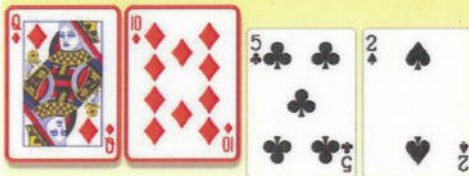

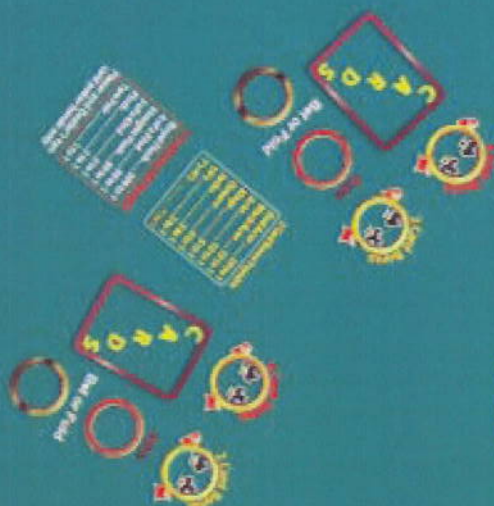
