#### **Commercial Card Rooms**

- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

#### Tribal Casinos

- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.

- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.






The dealer then exposes the 1 remaining community card and the dealer's 2 remaining cards, and selects 2 of the dealer's 3 cards to make the best 5 card poker hand for the dealer.

If the dealer's hand is lower than Ace-King, all of the players' **Ante Bets** are returned. If the dealer's hand is at least Ace-King and the player's hand beats the dealer's, the payout on the player's **Ante Bet** and **Raise Bet** is even money.

"2 Pair Plus Bonus" Wager: If the Player's final hand is 2-pairs or higher, this bet wins with odds, otherwise it loses.

"Player Bad Beat" Wager: If the Player loses the hand with a pair of Jacks or better, this bet wins with odds, otherwise it loses.
