

Notice of Permanent Rule Changes Related to Effective Dates

The rule identified below was repealed as the Gambling Commission no longer uses the effective date timelines outlined in the rule.

This explanatory statement concerns the Washington State Gambling Commission's repeal of WAC 230-01-015- Effective dates for rule-making orders.

The Administrative Procedure Act (<u>RCW 34.05.325(6)</u>) requires agencies to complete a concise explanatory statement before filing amended rules with the Office of the Code Reviser. This statement must be provided to anyone who provided comments regarding the proposed rule-making.

Once persons who provided comments during this rulemaking have had an opportunity to receive this document, the Washington State Gambling Commission will file the amended rules with the Office of the Code Reviser. These changes will become effective on October 10, 2021.
