Manufacturer Requirements:

- Blaze Gaming Surface was only tested for use with the TCS John Huxley Saturn Roulette Wheel and Saturn GLO Roulette Wheel.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- Ensure internal controls and or game rules are revised to include new equipment and procedures and are approved by the Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by the Washington State Gambling Commission.
