RE: I-DEAL PLUS Shuffler upgrade (signature changes noted below *) – GET Submission #3105

Dear Bo Zarach,

Thank you for requesting approval of the i-Deal Plus Shuffler. We have completed our review.

The i-Deal Plus Shuffler is approved for use in Washington State. The approval is contingent on the following requirements:

Manufacturer Requirements:

- All ethernet and USB service ports must be sealed while the shuffler is in play. The only exception is if i-Verify is being used for Pai Gow games. Shuffler software updates and GAT queries and authentication which require access to the USB and Ethernet ports should only be performed while the shuffler is out of service.
- Ensure there are no wireless devices listed in the "Setup", "Maintenance" and "Networking" menus.
- Ensure the "Shuffle Connect" button is grayed out in the set-up menu on the shuffler and the device is set to "Disabled".
- Ensure networking is disabled and that no ethernet cable is present that connects the shuffler to a server on premise.
- Any external tool connected to the shuffler must have all wireless and Bluetooth functions disabled at all times during the connection.
- Ensure the setting to connect to Electronic Table Games (ETG's) is disabled in the Game Selection menu on the shuffler and that there is no ethernet cable present that connects to an ETG. If a tribal casino has adopted an ETG Appendix and wish to connect this shuffler to an ETG, it must go through the field-testing process outlined in the ETG Appendix to be approved by both the Tribal Gaming Agency and Washington State Gambling Commission.

• The shuffler is approved to be deployed with the LTE modem (Multitech Telit ME910) for billing purposes only and must meet all requirements of WAC 230-16-152.

<u>Requirements for House-Banked Card Game Licensees:</u>

- Ensure only approved card games, as posted on the WSGC website, are played.
- Ensure the table betting limits and pay tables displayed on the shuffler agree with your approved internal controls and approved game rules.
- The "Enable Network" setting in the Network Menu must be set to "Disabled" before the shuffler is put into play.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- For Tribal Casinos, ensure internal controls are revised to include new equipment and procedures, and approved by Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by Washington State Gambling Commission.
- Ensure only approved card games, as posted on the WSGC website, are played.
- The "Enable Network" setting in the Network Menu must be set to "Disabled" before the Shuffler is put into play.
- Verify the shuffler is not physically located at an ETG table and that this feature is disabled in the Game Selection menu on the shuffler.
- Recommend including field testing parameters for the i-Deal Plus shuffler should a tribe wish to connect to a Light & Wonder ETG.
