Dear Ms. Rodriguez,

Thank you for requesting approval of the MDX Shuffler. We have completed our review.

The MDX Shuffler is approved for use in Washington State. The approval is contingent on the following requirements:

Manufacturer Requirements:

- All ethernet and USB service ports must be sealed while the shuffler is in play and only accessed by authorized maintenance personnel.
- Ensure there are no wireless devices listed in the "Setup", "Maintenance" and "Networking" menus.
- Ensure under the "Shuffleflex settings" on the operator menu, the device is set to "Disabled".
- Ensure only one external tool (such as a laptop) is connected to the shuffler via the ethernet port at a time. The shuffler must never be connected to any networking devices such as hubs, switches, or routers.
- Any external tool connected to the shuffler must have all wireless and Bluetooth functions disabled at all times during the connection.

Requirements for House-Banked Card Game Licensees:

- Ensure only approved card games, as posted on the WSGC website, are played.
- Ensure the table betting limits and pay tables displayed on the shuffler agree with your approved internal controls and approved game rules.
- The "Enable Network" setting in the Network Menu must be set to "Disabled" before the Shuffler is put into play.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- For Tribal Casinos, ensure internal controls are revised to include new equipment and procedures, and approved by Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by Washington State Gambling Commission.
- Ensure only approved card games, as posted on the WSGC website, are played.
- The "Enable Network" setting in the Network Menu must be set to "Disabled" before the Shuffler is put into play.
