Subject of possible rule making: Creating a regulatory structure to allow centralized surveillance of Class F and house-banked card rooms.

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 9.46.070

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish: Currently, WAC 230-15 requires Class F and house-banked card room licensees to maintain analog or digital closed-circuit television (CCTV) systems within their licensed premises that are monitored by the licensee's employees. This rule-making seeks to update the WAC to reflect advancements in technology that would allow for card rooms to implement centralized surveillance monitoring systems. This rule-making may take the form of amending WAC 230-15 and/or by creating a new rule.
