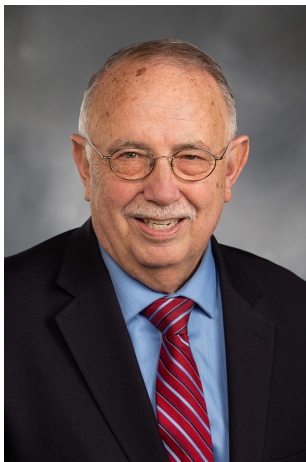

The meeting was held at the Liquor and Cannabis Board in Olympia, WA.

There were 5 people in the audience and 11 people attended virtually.

Chair Levy welcomed everyone to the Liquor and Cannabis Board and called the meeting to order at 9:31 AM.

She announced that the meeting would be recorded and took the roll to ensure a quorum.

Tab 1 – Consent Agenda, Election of Vice Chair, and Executive Director’s Report

Chair Levy asked the Commissioners if they had any changes to the consent agenda. They did not. She asked for public comment. There was none.

Commissioner Ibsen moved to approve the consent agenda.

Commissioner Lawson seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously. 4:0

Chair Levy opened the elections for a Vice Chair.

Commissioner Charles moved to elect Commissioner Lawson for Vice Chair with the term to begin immediately and serve through to the elections of new officers in 2025.

Commissioner Ibsen seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously. 4:0

Tina Griffin, Executive Director (ED), recognized Representative Kevin Waters as the newly appointed Ex-Officio to the Commission.

Tab 2 – Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation

Jim Melville, Special Agent (SA), and Alex Baier, NW Regional Lands Manager with the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, shared how the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation has used funds from licensed gambling activities to accomplish the organization’s mission. Mr. Baier also summarized the organization’s raffle plan to offer raffle prizes in excess of \$400,000 during their license year.

Chair Levy asked for public comment. There was none.

Commissioner Lawson moved to approve Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation’s request to offer raffle prizes in excess of \$400,000 during their license year ending June 30, 2025.

Commissioner Ibsen seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously. 4:0

At 10:16 AM the Commissioners took a break. The meeting resumed at 10:28 AM. A quorum was present.

Tab 3 – FY 25 Budget Update

Kriscinda Hansen, Chief Financial Officer, presented the materials for this tab.

Chair Levy asked if the Commissioners had any questions. There were no questions.

Tab 4 – Petition to Initiate Rulemaking – Card Cutting

Tricia Gullion, Legislative and Rules Manager (LRM) presented the materials for this tab.

Chair Levy asked if there was any public comment. There was no public comment.

Commissioner Lawson moved to deny the request because there have been no complaints regarding the issue and no regulatory concerns that have been expressed by staff.

Commissioner Charles seconded the motion.

The motion was approved. 4:0

Tab 5 – 2025 Legislative Update

LRM Tricia Gullion provided an update on the progress of HB 1222, our agency request legislation. LRM Gullion briefed several gambling related bills.

The Commissioners discussed whether to take a position on the bills. No position was taken on any of the bills briefed. The Commissioners asked staff to brief on these bills again next year.

Chair Levy asked if there was any public comment. There was no public comment.

Tab 6 – Agency Project Updates

Gary Drumheller, Deputy Director, provided updates on the agency’s IT modernization project, Polaris, a WaTech oversight project, and the conversion of our agency policies to Lexipol on February 1, 2025.

Chair Levy asked if there was any public comment. There was no public comment.

At 10:11 AM, **Chair Levy** announced the commissioners would take a 5-minute break before going into Executive Session for 30 minutes to discuss current and potential agency litigation including tribal negotiations.

At 10:31 AM, **Chair Levy** adjourned the meeting.

State agencies team up to promote Problem Gambling Awareness Month

OLYMPIA - The Washington State Gambling Commission, Washington's Lottery, and the Health Care Authority (HCA) are joining forces this March to promote Problem Gambling Awareness Month. While most Washington residents who gamble do so legally and for fun without harmful consequences, about 3.5 percent of adults who gamble experience serious negative impacts on their lives.

Publicly funded, no-cost, and confidential support is available to individuals and their loved ones affected by gambling related issues, including challenges in relationships, work, school, finances, and health.

"The Lottery offers fun and exciting games of chance while also supporting early childhood education and post-secondary scholarships and grants," said Kristi Weeks, Director of Legal Services at Washington's Lottery. "We encourage play as a form of entertainment only and never want players to spend their food, housing, or other essential money to gamble."

For those needing assistance with problem gambling, HCA provides free assessments and treatment services through [Apple Health \(Medicaid\)](#) and the [Washington State Problem Gambling Program](#). In addition to these services, many Tribal behavioral health programs also offer gambling treatment, and some private insurers may provide coverage. Individuals can reach out directly to these programs or contact the [Problem Gambling Helpline](#)  at **800-547-6133** (available 24/7 via chat, text, or call).

"Asking for help if you have a problem with gambling is hard, but there are many programs throughout the state to assist at no cost to those who want help," said Tina Griffin, Executive Director of the Washington State Gambling Commission.

The collaborating agencies want residents to know that for most, gambling is just a game. However, if gambling has become problematic, help is readily available.

"Problem Gambling Awareness Month is an excellent time to check in with yourself and evaluate gambling habits," said Roxane Waldron, Administrator for the Washington State's Problem Gambling Program. SUBJECT: March 2025 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

Today is the 60th day of this year's 105-day legislative session. The Commission has one agency-request bill for this session requesting a public records exemption. This legislation would exempt the proprietary financial and security information of our Tribal partners and licensees to keep financial documents, independent auditor reports and supporting documents of house-banked licensees and Tribal partner gaming facilities secure. Currently, HB 1222 has passed out of the House of Representatives and is now in the Senate. It has been referred to the Senate State Government, Tribal Affairs and Elections Committee.

Lawmakers must address a significant budget deficit this session and staff shared concerns with legislators regarding the damage a sweep of agency funds could do to our ongoing IT modernization project. As the session progresses, staff continue to meet with legislators and the governor's office to address these concerns.

Additionally, late last month, Governor Ferguson released his proposal for recommended cost saving measures to help address the budget shortfall. Prior to the announcement, he requested all state agencies to put together a 6% reduction exercise. We submitted a reduction plan that protected current staff while maintaining essential services for the people of Washington. In his plan, Governor Ferguson did not recommend reductions from our agency. However, he did include furloughs for most state employees over the next two years. These are only recommendations to the legislature; they are not final.

Next in the process, budget leaders from both the House and Senate will release their plans for the 2025-2027 operating budget. We will keep you updated on the budget outlook as the legislative session continues.

Self-Exclusion Program

The Gambling Commission's self-exclusion program began on May 1, 2022.

The program applies to all House-Banked Cardrooms.

A person can exclude themselves for 1, 3, 5 or 10 years. Once they serve the term they selected, then they can remove themselves from the exclusion.

Over 1,000 people have participated in this program since 2022.

An annual report for the program will be at the July commission meeting.
