Dear Ms. Perez,

Thank you for requesting approval to market the game of “Sic Bo – Game Description /Rules of play” to Washington State Tribal casinos utilizing Electronic Table Games (ETG’s).

Based on our review of the documentation we received from Interblock, the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game and special bets under the conditions listed below:

Tribal Casinos

- The game(s) shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the “Sic Bo – Game Description/Rules of play”
- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.
- No modifications may be made to allow the game to be played online or via the internet in Washington State.

In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.

- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be certified by the state and licensed by the Tribe prior to the sale of the equipment.

1 INTRODUCTION

Interblock's Sic Bo game is available in many hardware configurations. GUI is in two variations, one with white dice and one with red dice.

List of Interblock's machines where Sic Bo gameplay is available:

- Diamond Dice Generator with connected EGT Terminals,
- Diamond Big Dice Generator with connected EGT Terminals,
- Diamond Ministar Dice (configurations with 4, 6, 8, 10 connected EGT Terminals),
- Live Dice Table (Stadium, Pulse Arena variants) with dealer assist – community experience,
- Diamond Universal Cabinet (with Micro Dice topper – not available in all jurisdictions),
- Diamond Starbar (with internal RNG or connected to a mechanical or live external generator – not available in all jurisdictions),
- Diamond Bartop (with internal RNG or connected to a mechanical or live external generator – not available in all jurisdictions).

2 SIC BO GAME

The ancient Chinese game of Sic Bo offers players an entertaining single-roll dice game of chance. The objective of this popular casino game is to roll a chosen combination (or combinations) of dice in a single roll. There are various bets available on Interblock tables and all bets must be placed before hitting the “Roll” button. Players may place as many bets as they like, except the opposing bets (Even/Odd or Big/Small). Betting on two opposing bets at the same time is conditioned by casino and jurisdictional options.

All possible Sic Bo bets can be divided into two groups:

- Main bets, which are a part of every Sic Bo game, and
- Additional bets, which may be added to the main bets.

NOTE: Bet amounts and payouts are subject to different jurisdictions and/or casinos.



- **Values In:** This option allows the player to toggle between showing a currency format or a credits format for the playable credit information, current bet, last bet, and last win.
- **Help:** Displays the Dynamic Help screen.

4 Betting information

This information can be made less visible by using the brightness button next to the amount of credit available.

- **Last Win:** Displays the amount won in the previous game.
- **Last Bet:** Displays the last bet.
- **Playable:** Displays the available betting amount.
- **Bet:** Displays current wagered amount.

5 Betting field

The player can place various bets on this field. **NOTE:** The betting field may change by selecting different pay tables (this affects the visibility of the “Additional Bets”).

6 Denomination button, game controls and chips

- **Denomination button:** The denomination button sets the value of one credit and hence the value of the game. The selected value of one credit is displayed on the denomination button. Changing the denomination value (if available) also changes the wager amount for the “Play Now” feature. Denomination values can be set in the G4Settings software.
- **Clear last bet/Clear all bets:** Clears the last bet from the table. If pressed twice, all bets will be cleared from the table.
- **Double bet:** Doubles all bets on the table. If doubling all bets exceeds the player’s playable credit, only the first few bets will be doubled until the playable credit limit is reached.
- **Repeat last bet:** Repeats bets from the last game round. If there is no previous game round, it can repeat bet from the last game round across multiple games of the same type. This button can be set to auto repeat, if pressed for more than 3 seconds and confirming that decision.
- **Chips:** Eight chips are available for betting, each with a different value that the player can select and place on the table. Values assigned to chips are defined by the selected denomination.

7 History bar

Displays the last 50 dice results.

8 “Roll” button

Depending on how the game is setup in G4Settings, this button can be made visible or hidden. (Not applicable in all jurisdictions.)

4 SIC BO BETS

4.1 Main Bets

4.1.1 Three Dice Total

On these fields, a player bets that a specific three-dice sum ranging from 4 to 17 will be rolled. The totals of triples are excluded from this bet, since they are a part of the Triple Bets, and the player loses if a triple is rolled. For example, if three ones, three fives, three fours, etc. are rolled, the bet loses. The player can place chips on one or more betting positions.



4.1.2 Small and Big Bet

The Small bet and Big bet are two separate bets. They are actually Three Dice Totals divided into a group of “small” totals (totals ranging from 4 to 10) and “big” totals (totals ranging from 11 to 17). Triples are also excluded from this bet.



4.1.3 Triple Bet


With this bet, the player wagers that all three dice will show the same number. They may bet on a specific triple (e.g., three sixes) or on Any Triple. The latter is a bet that any three identical numbers will be rolled.

Bets on a specific triple can be placed on more than one betting field.



4.1.4 Double Bet

The bet wins if the same two numbers appear on two of the three dice and loses if a triple occurs. A Double Bet must not be mixed with a Pair Bet. The player can place their bets on as many doubles as they like.



4.1.5 Number Bet

Just as the name implies, this is a bet that a certain number will be rolled on any of the dice. The more numbers the player bets on correctly the higher the winnings. Bets can be placed on one or more betting positions.



4.1.6 Pair Bet

The player may also bet on certain numbers to appear on two of the three dice, which is considered a pair. A pair may be formed by different set of numbers, e.g., 3 and 5.
