Thank you for requesting approval to market the card game Match Super Bonus to Washington State commercial card rooms and Tribal casinos. Based on our review of the documentation we received from AGS LLC, the Washington State Gambling Commission will approve the game under the conditions listed below:

The game shall be played and operated under the terms and conditions set forth under the Match Super Bonus rules of play you provided and are enclosed.

Commercial Card Rooms

- Commercial card room operators seeking to operate this game must first submit their internal controls and receive approval from the Commission prior to implementing.
- Manufacturers and distributors of graphic layouts and/or any other equipment associated with the game must be licensed by the state prior to the sale of the equipment.

Tribal Casinos

- Each Tribal Gaming Operation must request and obtain approval from their respective Tribal Gaming Agencies (TGA).
- Before TGA allows your game to operate, they will seek concurrence from our agency as well.
- In addition to your approved rules, the Tribal submission to us must include all supplemental information required by Tribal-State Compact Appendix A, Section 18.

Rules and Procedures

INTRODUCTION

Match Super Bonus is an optional wager for standard Blackjack games. The player may place the ***Match Super Bonus*** wager at the beginning of the game before any cards are dealt.

- a. Operators cannot allow wagering limits to exceed the authorized limits set out in WAC 230-15-040 and WAC 230-15-140.
- b. All rules pertaining to standard blackjack as posted on the WSGC website remain the same except as noted in these rules of play.

Match Super Bonus wager can be offered on the first two player cards and the Dealer's face-up and/or down card when configured by the casino operator. If elected to have both versions of the game of Blackjack, it would require additional Match Super Bonus wagers to be added to the player positions of the felt game. If at least one of the player cards matches the Dealer card in rank, the wager wins. The player receives different pay according to whether both the player cards match, and whether one or more rank matches match in suit as well, see posted payable. If neither player card matches the Dealer card in rank, the wager loses.

RULES OF PLAY

1. To begin, Player's will place their normal base Blackjack wager and an optional Match Super Bonus wager(s).
2. Once all wagers have been placed, working from left to right, each Player is dealt their two initial cards while the Dealer receives cards according to the underlying Blackjack house rules.
3. If the Player initial two-cards and the Dealer face-up do not match pair, the wager loses, and the game of Blackjack continues by underlying Blackjack house rules. Once the Dealer face-down card is exposed, if it does not match pair, the wager loses, and the game of Blackjack continues by underlying Blackjack house rules.
4. If the Player initial two-cards and the Dealer face up and/or face-down does match, then the hand is evaluated to the posted payable.
5. Once all Match Super Bonus wagers have been settled, the game of blackjack continues per house rules.
