Thank you for submitting The Biggest Catch amusement game to us for review. Special Agents Karen Rea and Sonja Dolson have completed their review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

The player attempts to drop as many balls on the ship without tipping the ship. The player receives tickets for the number of balls they are able to balance on the ship (more balls = more tickets). If the player is able to balance all of the balls on the ship without tipping it they receive the bonus. The player may press the quit button at any time to stop play and collect their current ticket level. If any ball falls in the water the game play is over.

The Biggest Catch game is approved for use as Group V, hand/eye coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Biggest Catch amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, the approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
