Re: Dizzy Chicken Amusement Game

Dear Mr. Treankler

Thank you for submitting The Dizzy Chicken amusement game to us for review. Special Agents Karen Rea and Sonja Dolson have completed their review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

The player pulls a lever to hit a ball into a spiral track of lights. The color of the light the ball lands next to determines the number of tickets the player wins. For example, if the ball stops next to the blue lights the player wins ten tickets. If the player lands in a "Bonus Zone" they get the bonus prize plus another shot (in the same game) to win additional tickets with a new pattern of lights.

According to the information your representative provided, the sequence of the lights is the same in every game and the lights remain constant during game play. The position of the light pattern on the spiral moves but this only occurs between regular games and the bonus game. The position of the light pattern will move between regular games if a player is unable to achieve a bonus game after 4 consecutive games and after a long period of non play.

The Dizzy Chicken game is approved for use as Group V, hand/eye coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State. As you are aware, your representative was previously notified by e-mail regarding this approval. This letter will provide you with formal documentation of the approval.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Dizzy Chicken amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, the approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
