Thank you for submitting the Hot Shot amusement game, manufactured by SkeeBall Incorporated, to us for review. We have completed our review.

It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

Players shoot basketballs and are awarded tickets based on the number of baskets scored. Players are awarded two points for every basket scored and during the last seconds of the game, players receive three points for every basket scored.

The Hot Shot game meets the definition of an amusement game (RCW 9.46.0201) and is approved for use as a Group 1 Ball Toss (WAC 230-13-015) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Hot Shot amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. The approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
