Thank you for submitting The Pac-Man Ticket Mania game to us for review. Special Agents Karen Rea and Sonja Dolson have completed their review. It is my understanding the game plays as follows:

The player plays the standard game of Pac-Man. The player receives tickets based on the score they receive playing the game. If the player successfully passes the first level of the Pac-Man game with one life they have the opportunity to attempt to enter the Pac-Pot bonus area to receive additional tickets. The player must get to the Pac-Pot bonus area within a specific time period to win the bonus. The value of the bonus varies. The player receives the bonus that is available when they enter the Pac-Pot.

The Pac-Man game is approved for use as Group V, hand/eye coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Pac Man amusement game software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, the approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
