Dear Mr. Treankler,

Thank you for submitting the Ticket Monster amusement game to us for review. According to the information submitted, the Ticket Monster has the same game play as the previously approved Big Bass Wheel with an added feature; the monster jackpot. If the player lands on the monster jackpot spot they win the number of tickets displayed on the screen displayed at the top of the game. The amount of the monster jackpot remains constant during game play but will increase after each play if it isn't won.

In addition, it was noted that the software for the Ticket Monster amusement game has been modified for Washington State. Specifically, the player timeout option that allowed motor assist has been disabled. The WA version of the Ticket Monster game is approved for use as Group V, hand/eye coordination (WAC 230-13-035) amusement game in Washington State. As you are aware, your representative was previously notified by e-mail regarding this approval. This letter will provide you with formal documentation of the approval.

Please be advised that any modifications to the Ticket Monster amusement game, software or associated equipment must be provided to us for additional testing and review. In addition, the approval of this equipment may be rescinded at any time if problems are found by the Commission or changes to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) impact this approval.
