**AMENDED TO UPDATE PLAYER TRACKING CONNECTIONS:**

**Optima Keno System 7.4.1.0, Optima Desk 7.1, Optima Writer 7.2, Optima Display 7.0, Optima Audit 7.2, Optima Kiosk 7.8.1 (GAKMDD) and Airless Ball Caller System (AKAB-1) –Tribal Only Approval-GET Submission #2210**

Dear Ms. Merchant,

Thank you for requesting approval of the Gaming Arts Optima Keno System 7.4.1.0, Optima Desk 7.1, Optima Writer 7.2, Optima Display 7.0, Optima Audit 7.2, Optima Kiosk 7.8.1 (GAKMDD) and Airless Ball Caller System (AKAB-1). We have completed our review.

The Gaming Arts Optima Keno System 7.4.1.0, Optima Desk 7.1, Optima Writer 7.2, Optima Display 7.0, Optima Audit 7.2, Optima Kiosk 7.8.1 (GAKMDD) and Airless Ball Caller System (AKAB-1) is approved for use in Washington State Tribal Casinos.

Approval of the Optima Keno System is contingent on the following requirements:

Manufacturer Requirements:

- Ticket in Ticket out (TITO) connection capability to the Tribal Lottery System (TLS) is prohibited.
- Satellite Keno connection between multiple casinos is prohibited.
- Routers and wireless tablets need to be on a dedicated network separate from the casino network.
- Communications between all components of the Optima Keno System that include sensitive information which could compromise the security and integrity of the system, must be encrypted utilizing a currently practiced and recognized National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) encryption standard.
- Wireless tablets upon power up need to automatically boot into the Writer application.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- Ensure internal controls are revised to include new equipment, procedures and are approved by the Tribal Gaming Agency, and concurred with by the Washington State Gambling Commission.
- Ensure game rules are revised to include keno games to be offered and are approved by the Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by the Washington State Gambling Commission.
- Ensure no wireless keyboards are attached to the Kiosk.
- Secure all unused ports on the kiosks, tablets, and Keno system PCs.

Recommendation for player tracking connection:

- It is recommended, that TLS player tracking systems be connected via a firewall to the Optima Keno System.

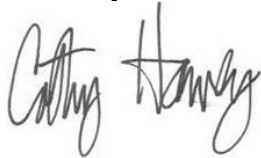
The electronic signatures for the system can be found on the attached documents from the Washington State Gambling Commission Electronic Gambling Lab.

We reserve the right to investigate and re-evaluate this equipment if we determine that such a review is necessary to ensure compliance with tribal state compacts or rules and laws of Washington.
