Dear Ms. Abad,

Thank you for requesting approval of the TCS John Huxley e-FX Elite 2, 29" Display. We have completed our review of the display and it is approved for use in Washington State Tribal Casinos.

Approval of the e-FX Elite 2, 29" Display is contingent on the following requirements:

Manufacturer Requirements:

- The e-FX Elite 2, 29" Display, was tested with and is only approved for use with TCS John Huxley roulette wheels.
- The software approved for use on the display must be sent on a USB to the Tribal Gaming Agency for a software verification to be completed prior to installation. The only way for this software to be signed is via the directory located on the USB. (See attached Electronic Gambling Lab approval for details.) Software cannot be verified post installation on the display.

Tribal Casino Implementation:

- Ensure internal controls are revised to include new equipment, and procedures and are approved by the Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by the Washington State Gambling Commission.
- Ensure game rules are revised to include the use of the e-FX Elite 2, 29" Display and are approved by the Tribal Gaming Agency and concurred with by the Washington State Gambling Commission.

The electronic signature for the display can be found on the attached documents from the Washington State Gambling Commission Electronic Gambling Lab.

Any modifications made to the TCS John Huxley e-FX Elite 2, 29" Display, must be submitted to us for additional testing and review. We reserve the right to investigate and re-evaluate this equipment if we determine that such a review is necessary to ensure compliance with tribal state compacts or rules and laws of Washington.

Please notify Special Agent Julie Kerkof at [Julie.kerkof@wsgc.wa.gov](mailto:Julie.kerkof@wsgc.wa.gov) at least 2 weeks prior to any scheduled installation of the e-FX Elite 2, 29" Display into a tribal casino.
