-Public Meeting-

Chair Sizemore welcomed everyone to the Gambling Commission meeting at the Hampton Inn and Suites in Olympia. He called the meeting of the Washington State Gambling Commission to order at 11:05 a.m. on March 9, 2017. Commissioner Kelsey Gray joined the meeting via phone. Introductions were made.

There were about 24 people in attendance.

Tab 1a

Consent Agenda:

February Commission Meeting Minutes/February Special Meeting Minutes/New Licensees Commissioner Patterson moved to approve the Consent Agenda as presented.

Commissioner Stearns seconded the motion.

The motion passed. 4:0

Snoqualmie Class III Gaming Employees Licensees

Commissioner Troyer moved to approve Snoqualmie Class III Gaming report as presented. Commissioner Patterson seconded the motion.

The motion passed. 3:0

Commissioner Stearns abstained.

Director's Update:

Director Trujillo recognized three employees for their State Service. The recognized employees had their pictures taken with the Commissioners.

- Michelle Rancour for 10 years of State Service.
- Elizabeth O'Hara for 15 years of State Service.
- Jessica Quiles for 16 years of State Service. Jessica is leaving the Gambling Commission and her last day will be March 10.

Tab 1b Legislative Update

Brian Considine presented the legislative report to the Commissioners. The Gambling Commission started the 2017 legislative session with following roughly 100 bills and as of the March 8th cutoff date the Gambling Commission had roughly 45 bills to follow. Brian highlighted a few of the top bills that the Gambling Commission is following.

HB 1274 (agency request legislation) removes the requirement that a bona fide charity or nonprofit have no less than 15 active members, each with the right to an equal vote in the election of the officers, or board members, if any, who determine the policies of the organization. HB 1274 was passed out of Senate Commerce, Labor & Sports Committee on March 9. HB 1274 is the companion bill to SB 5190. HB 5190 will be heard March 13 in a Public hearing at 1:30 p.m. in House Commerce and Gaming Committee. HB 1475 (also agency request legislation) authorizes an officer of the gambling commission who is designated with police powers to take action to prevent physical injuries or substantial damages to a person or property under certain circumstances. HB 1475 was also passed out of Senate Commerce, Labor & Sports Committee on March 9.

SB 5671 simplifies the process for bona fide charitable and non-profit organizations to engage in activities and social pastimes and raise funds for their authorized purposes was heard and passed in the Senate. SB 5671 was passed out of the Senate on March 3. The Commissioners still oppose the SB 5671 but would change their position to neutral if the bill is amended to only contain the 4 raffles/\$10,000 provision. Staff could work with the sponsor on other issues in the interim.

Brian also spoke about HB 2103. HB 2103 would require the legislature to appropriate, from the state general fund, money sufficient to fund the commission's law enforcement powers, duties and authority. This bill is sponsored by Representative Sawyer and was referred to the Appropriations Committee on February 14. This bill did not get a hearing in the House. Brian stated the bill would be "necessary to implement the budget"; therefore, action could still be taken on the bill.

Tab 2

Problem Gambling Awareness Month Presentation

Elizabeth Glavish, Evergreen Council on Problem Gambling (ECPG) and Brad Galvin, Lummi Nation, presented. Maureen Greeley was not able to attend the meeting. Elizabeth thanked Amy and the Gambling Commission for their support during Problem Gambling Awareness Month.

She also thanked Commissioner Patterson and Director Trujillo for their participation in making a short video regarding Problem Gambling. ECPG is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit that provides training, treatment and awareness on the issue of problem gambling and gambling addiction. March is the official National Problem Gambling Awareness Month and Governor Inslee has named March Problem Gambling Awareness Month for Washington as well. Brad Galvin from Lummi Nation spoke about what problem gambling programs Lummi Nation offers and what they will be doing for Problem Gambling Awareness Month. Brad runs the responsible gambling program department at Lummi Nation in Bellingham. He is a mental health counselor, a chemical dependency professional and a national certified gambling counselor. A big part of what Lummi Nation does for Whatcom County is geared around advocating and supporting the community. People throughout Whatcom County can utilize the services at Lummi Nation. Lummi Nation recognizes there's a much higher prevalence of gambling addictions among their tribal members. They also support community events. They have a 26 week group curriculum for gambling addiction. They also provide family counseling. Two or three times a month Brad presents to chemical dependency and outpatient groups. For more information on Lummi Nation problem gambling programs contact Brad Galvin at 360-312-2019.

The Gambling Commission meeting adjourned for Executive Session at 12:22. The meeting reconvened at 2:55 pm and was immediately adjourned.

Licenses Held in Other Jurisdictions:

Genesis Gaming Solutions, Inc. is currently licensed to conduct business in 76 state and Native American gaming jurisdictions, including Nevada, Arizona, Kansas, Oregon, and Pennsylvania. They also have applications pending in several other jurisdictions.

Part II Licensing Investigation Summary

A Special Agent from the Commission's Licensing Unit conducted a criminal history and financial investigation focusing on funding sources and beneficiaries for suitability in accordance with RCW 9.46 and WAC 230. An agent went on-site to Genesis Gaming Solutions' headquarters in Spring, Texas, and manufacturing facilities in Las Vegas, Nevada, to conduct the investigation, which included verifying the ownership structure, reviewing financial and business records, conducting interviews and observing the manufacturing and development process.

The investigation found:

- No unreported people or businesses involved (i.e. substantial interest holders);
- No undisclosed ownership or undisclosed involvement in other activities/businesses;
- No disqualifying administrative history;
- · All funding sources were disclosed; and
- All substantial interest holders qualify to hold a license.

Genesis Gaming Solutions, Inc. entered into a Settlement Agreement with the Commission for selling unapproved equipment prior to licensure.

Source of Funds:

The source of funds to start their business in Washington came from cash on hand and shareholder loans.

Part III Staff Recommendations

Based upon the criminal history and financial background investigations, staff recommends licensing Genesis Gaming Solutions, Inc. as a Class "B" Manufacturer.

SUBJECT: LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

New Ex Officio

Senator Lynda Wilson has been appointed to replace Senator Hewitt as our ex officio (letter attached). Senator Wilson represents the 17th District in Clark County. Senator Wilson is serving her first term in the Senate. Previously, she was in House of Representatives in 2015-16. Senator Wilson is on the Senate Commerce, Labor, and Sports Committee—the policy committee responsible all gambling-related bills. She also is the Chair of the Higher Education Committee and on the Law and Justice, and Transportation Committees.

Bill Summaries

April 12th is the cutoff for policy bills and April 23rd is Sine Die. At this time, we are currently tracking 39 bills that are still alive. Below is a summary of relevant bills that are still alive.

Agency Request Legislation

1. <u>HB 1274 / SB 5190, Concerning the voting member requirement for charitable and nonprofit organizations</u>

HB 1274 and SB 5190 were both voted out of the House (98-0) and Senate (48-1), respectively. The bills have been voted out of Committee, and both are currently in Rules in the opposite chamber. I am working to have HB 1274 voted out of the Senate by the April 12th cutoff. If there is a problem, I will work to have SB 5190 to be voted out of the House.

2. HB 1475 / SB 5582, Clarifying the limited authority of gambling commission officers

HB 1475 was passed out of the House 98-0. SB 5582 did not make it out of Senate Rules. HB 1475 was passed out of Committee and is currently in Senate Rules. I am working to have the bill voted out of the Senate by the April 12th cutoff.

State Budget Bills

3. <u>SHB 1067 / ESSB 5048 – Operating Budgets</u>

The Senate and House have voted on their budget bills, and are in the process of negotiating a final budget by the end of session. The Senate version does not ratify the Collective Bargaining Agreements (CBAs) negotiated with the Governor and, instead, it includes a \$500 annual salary increase for all state employees.

The House version ratifies all of the CBAs, including a 6% Cost of Living Adjustments (COLAs) applied to all state employees. The COLAs are to occur in three phases over two years—2% on July 1, 2017; 2% on July 1, 2018; and 2% on January 1, 2019.

Both budgets keep state employee healthcare costs the same, but increases them slightly for the agency. Also, the Gambling Revolving Account is left whole, and there is no state funding for the agency.

The Legislature has until April 23rd to negotiate and pass a final budget or there will likely need to be a special session until a budget agreement is reached.

Bills with Direct Gambling Impacts.

4. HB 2103, Concerning the gambling commission

Representative Sawyer is still advocating that we receive a new appropriated account to fund the Gambling Commission's law enforcement duties. I am drafting proposed statutory and proviso language that we will provide to Representative Sawyer and legislative staff in the next couple weeks.

I do not know the likelihood of us receiving a general fund appropriation. If it occurs, the budget language will likely be finalized at the end of the budget negotiation process and that could include a special session(s).

Bills Impacting Agency's Adjudicative or Rule-making Authority

5. <u>2SHB 1120</u>, Concerning the regulatory fairness act

2SHB 1120 implements State Auditor recommendations to Small Business Economic Impact Statements (SBEIS) used in agency rule-making. This bill is being worked by the Governor's office in consultation with state agencies. We do not have concerns at this time. The bill is in Senate Ways and Means. It will likely be passed out of the committee and out of the Senate by the April 12th cutoff.

Law Enforcement Bills

6. ESSB 5038 Concerning disclosures regarding incentivized evidence and testimony

ESSB 5038 requires: a prosecutor's office to request from law enforcement information about an informant, specifically the informant's criminal history, any benefit received for being an informant, information related to the information provided by the informant, other cases, if any, where the person was an informant.

ESSB 5038, incentivized evidence and testimony (continued)

This bill will likely require additional work for our special agents when they use an informant. WASPC and WAPA have opposed the bill and are working to amend the language. This bill is in House Rules, and it is unclear if this bill will be pulled from Rules and passed into law. Staff has concerns with this bill, but I am not recommending you take an action at this time.

Public Meeting / Public Disclosure Bills

7. ESHB 1594, Improving public records administration

ESHB 1594: (1) requires Public Records Officers to receive training on managing electronic records; (2) clarifies how agencies can respond to unclear records requests under the Public Records Act (PRA); (3) requires a feasibility study on a statewide records portal that all public records requests and disclosures would go through; (4) defines records held by certain volunteers as records not disclosable under the PRA; (5); requires agencies to keep a PRA log; (6) requires agencies with PRA costs of more than \$40,000 to report certain metrics to JLARC; and (7) other public records assistance for local governments.

The bill passed out of committee and is currently in Senate Ways and Means. The current version differs from the House version and a compromised will need to be reached if it passes out of the Senate. Staff has some concerns with (6) above, but I am not recommending that you take any action on this bill at this time.

8. EHB 1595, Concerning costs associated with responding to public records requests

EHB 1595: (1) authorizes agencies to charge for providing copies of electronically produced public records and sets a default fee schedule for such records; (2) authorizes a customized service charge for locating and preparing public records for exceptional complex requests; (3) provides that a request for all or substantially all agency records is not a valid request for identifiable records under the Public Records Act; and (4) allows agencies to deny frequent automatically generated requests for public records that would interfere with the other essential functions of the agency.

The bill passed out of committee and is currently in House Rules. It is unclear if this bill will be voted out of the House. If it is, this bill could be beneficial to the agency and staff does not have concerns at this time.

Tribal Compact Hearing

9. Squaxin Island Compact Amendment Hearing

A Joint Committee Meeting was held in the House on March 28, 2017. Members of the House Commerce and Gaming and Senate Commerce, Labor, and Sports Committees were present. Deputy Director Amy Hunter, Tribal Liaison Julie Lies, and Squaxin Island Tribal Liaison and Gaming Commissioner Ray Peters presented the compact amendment to the joint committee. Chair Sizemore and Commissioner Stearns were also present.
