SUBJECT: WARNING LETTER AND ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Dear Ms. Bixby:

On August 9, 2013, a Notice of Administrative Charges and Opportunity for an Adjudicative Proceeding were issued to you, seeking revocation of your gambling license. On August 23, 2013, Commission staff received your request for a hearing.

These administrative charges were issued against your license following an investigation, which included witness statements and documents. The charges allege that you took \$80 from another player while playing Blackjack. If such allegations were proven, these actions would be in violation of RCW 9.46.153(1). In addition, the Washington State Gambling Commission would have grounds to revoke your license pursuant to RCW 9.46.075(1), (8), and (10) and WAC 230-03-085(1), and (8).

After further investigation and reconsideration, we have decided to dismiss the above charges without prejudice; an Order of Dismissal is enclosed with this correspondence. The Washington State Gambling Commission regulates gambling, in part, with voluntary compliance from licensees. Accordingly, we trust you will continue to comply with state gambling laws and Commission rules. Please contact Jennifer Stretch, Paralegal, at (360) 486-3465, if you have any questions or concerns.

On August 9, 2013, the Director of the Washington State Gambling Commission issued Tiffany K. Bixby Administrative Charges for revocation of her gambling license. The charges were based upon allegations that the licensee, while playing Blackjack stole \$80 in chips from another player.

Following issuance of the Administrative Charges, Director Trujillo determined that the warning letter issued on November 22, 2013, is sufficient to resolve this matter, and that the Administrative Charges against Tiffany K. Bixby should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Commission's Notice of Administrative Charges be dismissed without prejudice.


