To whom it may concern:

The Gambling Commission would like to withdraw CR-102 WSR 20-19-084, filed on September 16, 2020, proposing to amend WAC 230-06-035, Credit, loans, or gifts prohibited, and WAC 230-14-047, Standards for electronic video pull-tab dispensers, to accept credit cards as a payment method option for card games, pull-tabs, and bingo.

At their December 17, 2020 public meeting, Commissioners chose to withdraw rule-making at this time citing that there needed to be more analysis and stakeholder work on how the proposed rule may contribute to problem gambling and a broader discussion on the role of credit cards used in the gambling industry.
